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## BEHAVIOUR POLICY

In the interests of everybody's safety it is paramount that good behaviour is shown throughout every session. Where behaviour is incongruent with the clubs expectations and poses a danger to other members or coaches, specific actions may be necessary. We outline below our method for dealing with such behaviour where it poses a direct risk that is not compliant with our expectations:

- Step 1 A reminder of good behaviour and our expectations will be directed to the child. This will be done in a firm but fair manner and should mostly be enforcing the level of behaviour that is expected.
- Step 2 Should the behaviour continue then a verbal warning will be issued to the child. The verbal warning will take the place of reminding the child that if they are unable to follow the rules in place that they will be taken to a safe area away from their class to reflect and remind the child of the safety measures they need to adhere to.
- Step 3 Should neither Steps 1 or 2 prove effective then the child will be removed from the class and the parent will be contacted to come and collect the child.

For any children where Step 2 has been necessary we will email the parent to alert them of the situation. Please ensure that you have provided us with a suitable contact telephone number and that you have availability to this number for the duration of your child's class. Please do all you can to encourage your child to adhere to the safety measures in place to avoid Step 3 coming into effect.
